Tour of Spectacle Island (self-pay) PSI's Sierra Fletcher will lead a tour of Boston Harbor's Spectacle Island. The Spectacle Island visitor center demonstrates renewable energy, oriented with a roofline facing south so a solar electric (photo voltaic) system could be installed with maximum solar gain.

Spectacle Island features a marina, visitor center, two sandy beaches, and five miles of walking trails that will lead visitors to the crest of a 157 foot-high hill, offering magnificent panoramic views of the harbor and the city.

Nexus Green Roundtable (Free, self-guided tour)
 NEXUS is an independent non-profit organization whose mission is to mainstream green, healthy, efficient, and intentional building and development. NEXUS is both a green building museum and green tradeshow.
